STUDENT HEALTH AND WELFARE
EMERGENCY NURSING SERVICES

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9 The objective of the district's emergency nursing services is to maintain the physical, mental and
10 emotional health of students while they are at school and/or participating in school activities.
11 Emergency nursing services shall be available during the school day including curricular and
12 extracurricular activities.

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14 Emergency nursing services shall be provided under the direction of a school nurse and medical
15 direction shall be provided through a local physician designated by the Board.

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17 Emergency information shall be updated by each student's parent/guardian at the beginning of
18 the school year or upon admission to a district school. Any student who suffers a sudden illness
19 or injury while under the school's supervision shall be treated in accordance with established
20 guidelines. Liability insurance for all district personnel shall be provided by the Board.

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22 Equipment and supplies adequate for emergency nursing services in accordance with standards
23 set by the Department of Public Instruction (DPI) and the Department of Health and Human
24 Services shall be readily accessible in a health service area in each school and first aid kits shall
25 be kept in laboratory areas.

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27 A daily log of all health room visits shall be maintained in accordance with established guidelines.
28 The information may be used for medical referrals and for noting visit trends or frequency.
29 Confidentiality standards shall be maintained in accordance with state and federal laws and
30 regulations and Board policy.

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32 A written statement of the district's emergency care for sudden illness and injury procedures shall
33 be distributed annually to all school personnel and parents/guardians. An annual review of
34 emergency nursing services shall be made by the Board in accordance with established
35 guidelines.
