STUDENT HEALTH AND WELFARE
DO NOT RESUSCITATE (DNR)

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9 The Blair-Taylor School District recognizes that it may serve students with complex health needs.
10 Due to some of these complex and serious medical conditions the district has created a policy in
11 regards to Do Not Resuscitate (DNR) Orders.

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13 The Blair-Taylor School District has the obligation to provide a free and appropriate public
14 education to students. The primary mission of the district is education. The district will not directly
15 honor any DNR order or request. However, we will keep the DNR order secured at building site
16 where the student is located and a copy at the K-6 health office. Emergency personnel will be
17 provided the DNR order upon arrival.

18
19 District staff will provide emergency care and assistance when a student is undergoing a medical
20 emergency during school or school activities until certified medical personnel arrive.

21
22 District staff will activate emergency medical services (911) as soon as possible when a student
23 is undergoing a medical emergency during school or school activities. The DNR order will be
24 provided to emergency medical personnel upon arrival.

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26 The parent/guardian will be notified of the emergency as soon as possible.

27
28 Individual Education Program and Section 504 teams must develop individualized medical
29 emergency care plans for students when appropriate in accordance with state and federal law.

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31 Parents/guardians who request a DNR order be honored shall be advised of and shall be given a
32 copy of this policy.
