**STUDENTS**  
**MISCELLANEOUS STUDENT POLICY**  
**STUDENT VEHICLE USE**

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9 There are numerous reasons that a student may have a need to drive a vehicle to school. Recognizing this  
10 need, the following procedures are to be observed:

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12 1. Student vehicles (including motorcycles) driven to school are to be parked in the student parking  
13 lot. Snowmobiles should be parked in an area designated by the building principal. Vehicles  
14 driven to school are to remain in the parking lot until the end of the school day unless permission  
15 is received from the principal.  
16 2. Vehicles should be locked once they are parked. The school district is not responsible for  
17 vandalism or theft concerning student vehicles.  
18 3. All operations of student vehicles on school premises should be done in a reasonable, prudent,  
19 and lawful manner, including parking in an orderly fashion.

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21 **ALTERNATIVE, CO-OP, PROJECT CIRCUIT, YOUTH APPRENTICESHIP, WORK STUDY**

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23 Students involved in Alternative Education, Project Circuit, Youth Apprenticeship, or Work Study classes  
24 are to ride a bus to and from such classes if one is provided.

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26 Students taking Alternative Education, Project Circuit, Youth Apprenticeship, or work study classes shall  
27 be responsible for their own transportation to and from such classes or work experiences. No mileage  
28 shall be paid by the School District for such classes or work experiences.

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30 **UNIVERSITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE CLASSES**

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32 Students may take classes during the school day from a University or Technical College through the  
33 Post-Secondary Enrollment Options program. This requires Board approval and a determination of  
34 whether or not high school credit will be awarded. There shall be no mileage paid by the School District  
35 for such classes. Families wishing to pursue mileage based on financial need may make a written  
36 request to the State Superintendent of Schools for this purpose. If approved, this will be paid by the  
37 State.

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39 **DISTRICT VEHICLE USE**

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41 Under no circumstances will students be given keys to or allowed to operate any district motorized vehicle  
42 or equipment.
